Pre-admission Clinic



At Frankston Private Hospital it is essential that all our patients undergoing any surgeries requiring an overnight stay, to attend our pre-admission clinic approximately one to two weeks prior to their procedure.

Why is Pre-admission Clinic important?

- To reduce the risk of avoidable delays/cancellations of surgery through patient assessment and education by our highly qualified, professional nursing staff.
- To provide vital information regarding how to achieve the best outcome from your surgery and minimise the risk of complications.
- To help reduce patient anxiety due to the fear of the unknown, answering any questions you may have, which helps to promote a more confident, speedy recovery.
- To address any post op care needs such as rehabilitation.

What topics are discussed?

- All relevant tests, procedures, investigations and appointments to be attended prior to surgery
- Medications to be withheld or continued prior to surgery
- Assessment of history details
- Fasting instructions, admission procedure
- Pain management
- Physiotherapy
- Restrictions, precautions
- Equipment to hire/buy prior to discharge
- Discharge planning
- Any questions you have.
